



Zygopetalums

- **Keep above 40F for best result in winter.**
- **Keep moist, but well drained media.**
- **Bright light but keep leaves from overheating with good air movement.**
- **Wonderful strong hyacinth fragrance.**
- **Bloom in spring and possibly again in fall.**
- **Some black spotting on the leaves is typical.**



Epidendrums

- **Small flowered lavender type can take temperatures down to freezing..**
- **Yellow, orange and red types need temperatures no lower than 50F in winter for optimal growth and flowering.**
- **Like plenty of water and fertilizer when in active growth**

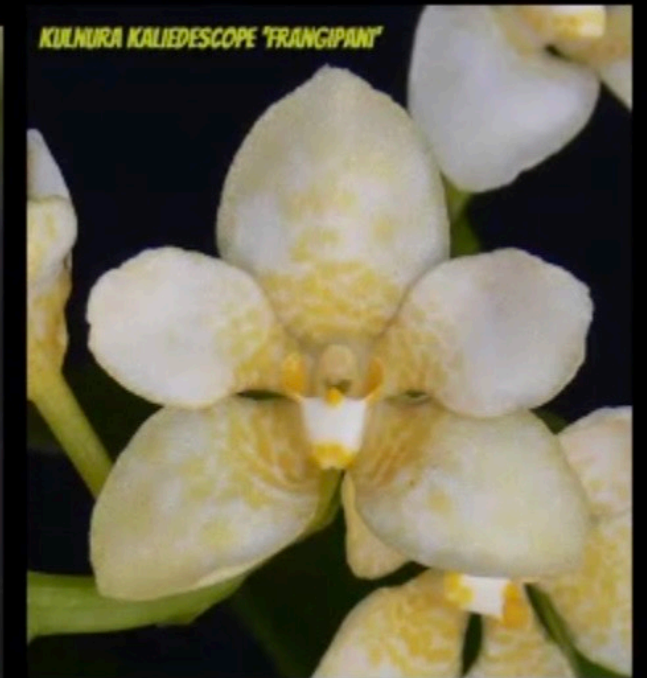
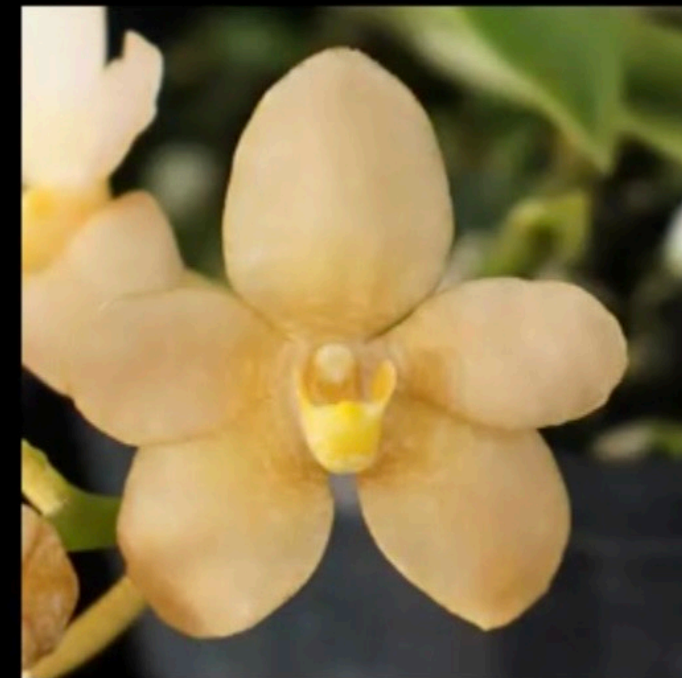
Some Vanda orchids are very temperature tolerant



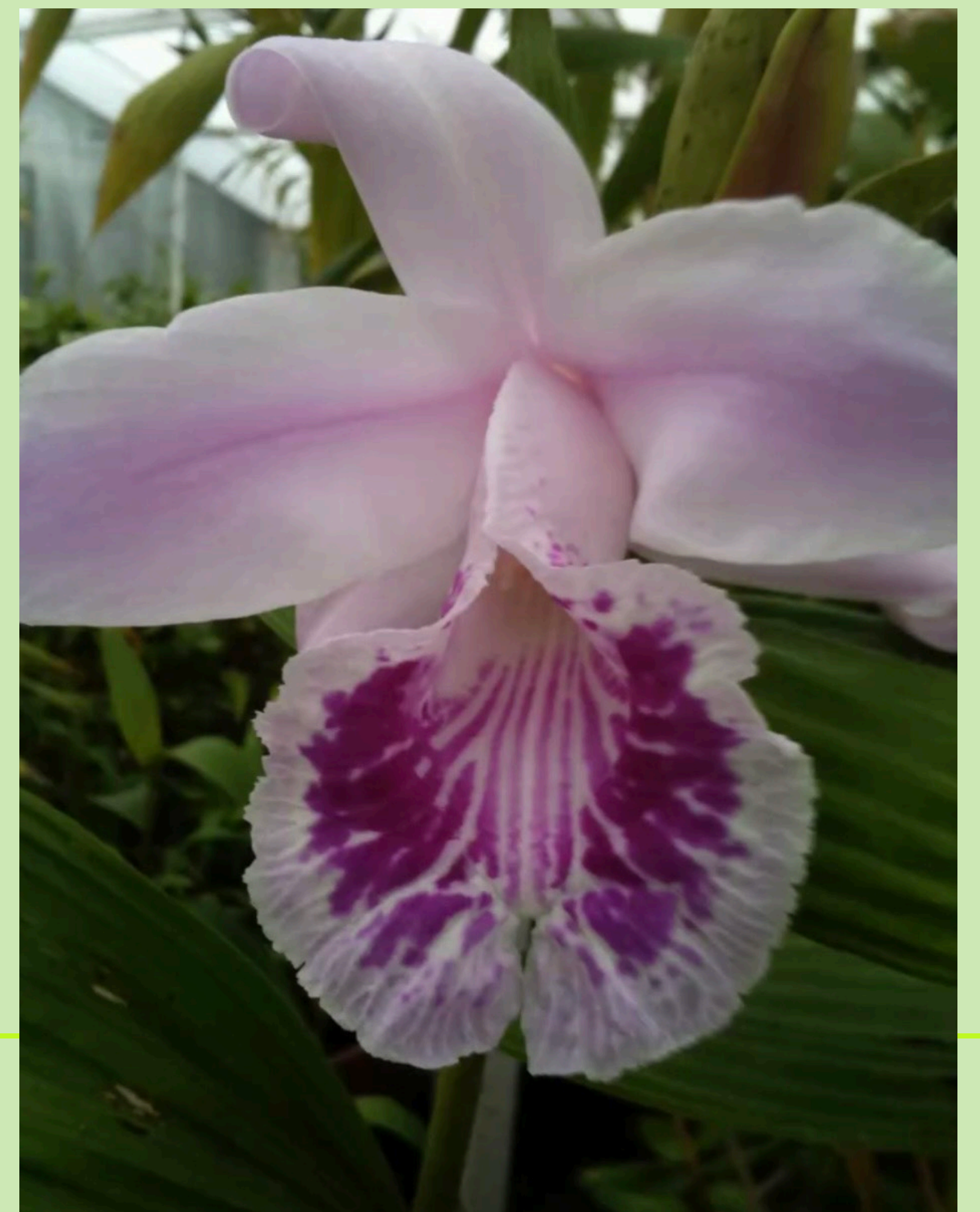
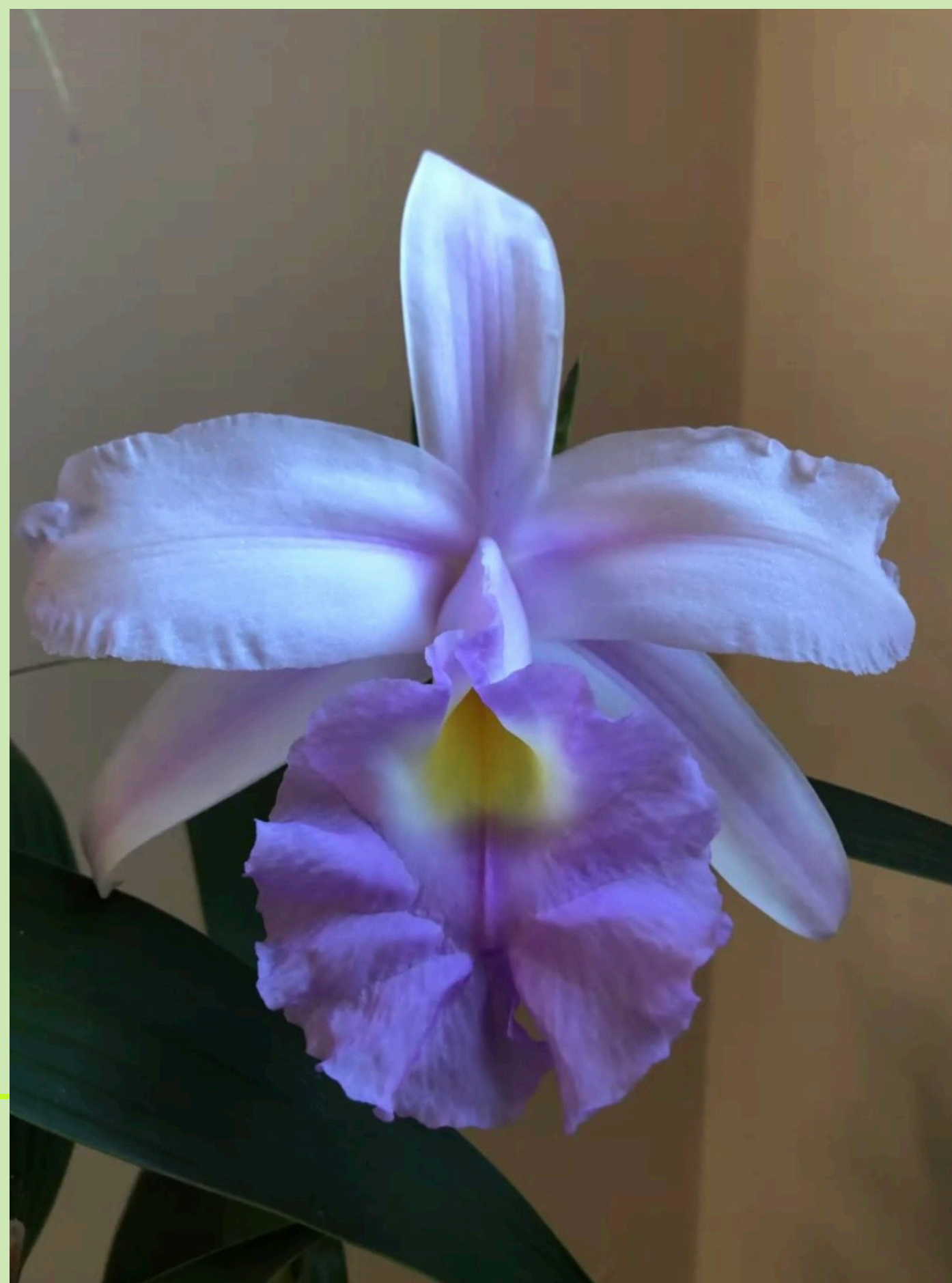
Vanda coerulea and it's hybrids
